

**The Jack Galmiche Endowed Scholarship**  
**2022-2023**  
**Award Amount: \$1,350**

The School of Communications is pleased to announce the Jack Galmiche Endowed Scholarship to preserve Galmiche's legacy of community service and to support students pursuing internships with Nine PBS or other non-profit, public-service communication and media.

Jack Galmiche was the President and CEO of the Nine Network, St. Louis' PBS affiliate, for nearly 13 years until his sudden passing in 2019. He was a strong advocate for the power of public media to be an agent for positive change. Galmiche was well known for his service to the Webster community and the entire St. Louis region, along with his commitment to the public broadcasting community nationwide.

Interested students should apply for the scholarship award through the procedures listed below and concurrently apply for an internship with Nine PBS, preferably, or another non-profit, community-service communication or media agency. The scholarship winner will be selected from among those selected for an internship.

Students who are enrolled in a for-credit internship course and who accept an offered internship, may be granted a tuition scholarship of value up to equal the then current per-credit hour tuition rate for up to three credit hours (currently \$1,350). The internship may be completed in either semester of the 2022-23 academic year.

Interested students must

- be able to meet the requirements of MDST 4950 Internship within the academic year,
- submit the application form, with
- a one-page essay on their career aspirations and their vision of communication in the public interest.

Simultaneously, students should apply for an internship with Nine PBS or another non-profit communication and media organization.
